

2026 Cable Tray Installation Standard



Article Overview

The 2026 NEC requires cable trays to maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance, proper fill limits, grounding, and separation of power and data cables to ensure safe and compliant installations.

Key Installation Requirements

Clearances and Access: Cable trays must have a minimum of 12 inches of vertical clearance above them to allow for installation and maintenance, as specified in NEC Section 392.18(F) (2026 update) . Unsupported cable spans from tray to equipment cannot exceed 6 feet; additional supports are required for longer spans . For outdoor installations, expansion splice plates should be used to accommodate thermal expansion and contraction . **Cable Types:** Only tray-rated cables such as Type TC, Metal-Clad (MC), or Power-Limited Tray Cable (PLTC) are permitted . These cables are designed to withstand heat, moisture, and mechanical stress typical in tray applications. **Tray Fill Limits:** Proper fill is critical to prevent overheating and maintain accessibility. For power cables, the fill must not exceed 40% of the tray's cross-sectional area; for control or low-voltage cables, the limit is 50% . Ladder trays provide the best ventilation, while solid-bottom trays offer maximum protection but require stricter fill limits due to reduced heat dissipation . **Separation and EMI Prevention:** High-power and low-power cables must be separated to prevent electromagnetic interference (EMI). Signal and data cables should be routed separately from power cables, and proper spacing should be maintained . **Grounding and Bonding:** Metallic trays can serve as equipment grounding conductors (EGC) if they meet NEC requirements. Grounding and bonding are mandatory to ensure electrical safety . **Cable Securing:** Cables should be fastened to tray members in ver...
