No Electricity Required: Unlike fusion splicing, cold-joint methods do not need power or welding equipment, which is beneficial in remote or field environments . 3. Minimal Equipment Needs: Only basic tools like fiber cutters and quick connectors are required, reducing setup complexity . 4. Time-Saving: Cold splicing is faster than fusion splicing because it avoids the heating and fusion process, allowing for quicker network expansion or repairs . 5. Stable Quality for Short-Term Use: Cold connectors can provide stable connections with low splice loss (around 0.03–0.05 dB in some designs), suitable for short-distance or temporary installations .

Disadvantages

1. Higher Signal Loss: Cold-joint connections typically have higher insertion loss, around 0.1–0.2 dB per point, which can reduce overall signal quality and limit long-distance transmission . 2. Environmental Sensitivity: Connection quality can be affected by dust, humidity, or temperature variations, making them less reliable in...
