Household electrical distribution boxes are considered low-voltage equipment, not high-voltage.

Voltage Classification

Household electrical distribution boxes, often called breaker panels or service panels, operate at voltages typically ranging from 120 to 240 volts AC in residential settings, which falls within the low-voltage category according to both IEC and ANSI/NEC standards . High-voltage systems are generally defined as operating above 1,000 volts AC or 1,500 volts DC, used primarily for transmission and industrial applications . Medium-voltage systems, ranging from 1 kV to 35 kV, are used in primary distribution networks before stepping down to residential levels .

Function of Household Distribution Boxes

These boxes serve as the final stage of electricity distribution to homes. They receive power from a distribution transformer, which steps down medium-voltage electricity from the utility to safe, usable levels for residential use, typically 120/240 volts . Inside the box, circuit breakers or fuses manage and protect individual circuits, ensuring safe distribution of electricity throughout the home .
