

Bare Fiber Optic Cable Techniques

Bare fiber optic cables are ultra-thin, uncoated fibers that require precise handling, splicing, and protective measures to ensure reliable optical performance.

Understanding Bare Fiber

Bare fiber refers to the fundamental glass strand of an optical fiber without any protective coatings, buffers, or jackets, typically 125–250 microns in diameter. It consists of a core (8–9 μm for single-mode, 50–62.5 μm for multimode) and cladding, but lacks the durability of finished cables, making it extremely fragile and prone to breakage under minimal strain (). Bare fiber is commonly used in laboratory research, sensor systems, medical devices, and high-density data center applications ().

Handling Techniques

- **Fragility Awareness:** Bare fiber can break with just 1–2% strain, so all handling must be gentle. Avoid bending beyond the minimum bend radius and prevent contact with sharp edges ().
- **Cleaning:** Fiber ends must be cleaned with optical-grade wipes, swabs, or solvents to prevent contamination, which can cause signal loss. Use a wet wipe followed by a dry wipe and avoid back-and-forth scrubbing ().
- **Storage:** Store bare fibers in protective spools or trays to prevent accidental damage. Proper storage can preserve fibers indefinitely if handled carefully ().
