In most modern electrical systems, a blue wire typically serves as a neutral conductor, but its exact role can vary depending on the system type and regional wiring standards.

Function of the Blue Wire

In residential AC wiring, especially in the UK and other countries following IEC standards, the blue wire is generally used as the neutral wire. It completes the electrical circuit by providing a return path to the source, ensuring that current flows safely through the load and back to the distribution system. In three-phase systems, the blue wire may represent one of the phases, commonly L2, which helps balance loads across the three phases. Correct identification is critical to avoid miswiring, which could lead to equipment damage or safety hazards. In low-voltage or control circuits, blue wires can serve as signal or switched wires, connecting components such as sensors, switches, or control devices. In these cases, the blue wire does not carry full line voltage but is essential for proper system operation.

Regional Standards

- IEC (Europe, UK, and other countries): Blue is neutral in single-phase AC and may indicate L2 in three-phase AC.
- NEC (United States): Blue is not a standard color for neutral in single-phase AC; it is often used for hot wires in three-phase systems or for control wiring
