

Cable tray wall penetration budget

Cable tray wall penetrations typically match the tray width and depth, with prices ranging from around \$1 to \$5 per meter depending on material, fire rating, and supplier.

Sizing Considerations

The size of a cable tray wall penetration is primarily determined by the dimensions of the cable tray passing through the wall. Standard cable tray widths range from 50mm to 900mm, and depths from 50mm to 150mm, with most trays supplied in 3-meter sections . When planning a wall penetration, the opening should accommodate the outside width of the tray, which is slightly larger than the nominal inside width due to side rail thickness . This ensures proper fit, allows for cable fill, and maintains airflow for heat dissipation.

Additional factors affecting penetration size include:

- Fire-resistance rating: Openings may require fire-rated sleeves or seals (1-hour or 2-hour ratings) to comply with local building codes .
- Material compatibility: Common materials include galvanized steel, aluminum, and stainless steel (304/316) .
- Sealing requirements: Smoke and gas sealing may be necessary in plenum or hazardous areas .
- Load-bearing capacity: The penetration system must support the weight of the cable bundle with a safety margin

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In vertical wall penetrations, weatherproofing cable trays is often carried out using a weatherstop sealing system.
