A standard home router cannot directly accept a fiber optic cable because fiber transmits data as light pulses, while routers are designed to handle electrical signals over Ethernet. To bridge this gap, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is used. The ONT converts the fiber optic signal into a standard Ethernet signal that your router can process. You then connect the ONT to your router's WAN port using an Ethernet cable, allowing the router to manage your home network just like it would with DSL or cable internet .

Fiber-Ready Routers

Some modern routers come with SFP or SFP+ ports, which can directly accept fiber modules. These routers can connect to the fiber network without a separate ONT, but the module must be compatible with your ISP's fiber service. SFP+ modules are often hot-swappable and support high-speed connections, making them suitable for multi-gigabit fiber setups .
