Single-Mode Fiber (SMF) Capacity

Single-mode fiber has a narrow core of about $9\text{ }\mu\text{m}$, allowing only one mode of light to propagate. This eliminates modal dispersion, which is the main factor limiting distance in optical communications, enabling long-distance transmission exceeding 40 km without significant signal degradation .

- **Bandwidth Potential:** Virtually unlimited; single-mode fiber can support data rates from 10 Gbps up to 800 Gbps or more depending on transceivers and wavelength-division multiplexing (WDM) technology .
- **Distance:** Can reach tens of kilometers to over 100 km without amplification, making it ideal for carrier networks, metropolitan backbones, and long-haul links .
- **Light Source:** Typically uses laser diodes at 1310 nm or 1550 nm, optimized for low attenuation and high coherence . Single-mode fiber is the preferred choice for future-proofing networks, as upgrading bandwidth often only requires changing transceivers rather than the fiber itself .
