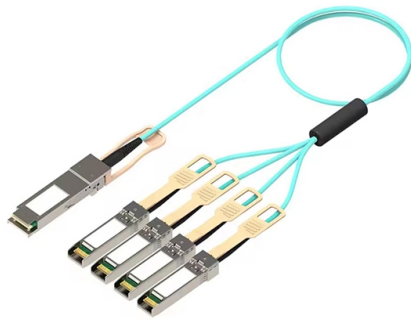


Cause of secondary distribution box burnout
