Overheating due to frequent operation or high ambient temperatures can also degrade relay components and insulation .

Relays are sensitive to environmental conditions. High humidity, dust, vibration, or exposure to corrosive substances can cause insulation breakdown, corrosion of contacts, or mechanical sticking . Temperature extremes outside the relay's rated operating range can accelerate aging and reduce reliability .
