Fiber optic cables offer much higher data speeds and bandwidth than coaxial cables, though coax can have lower latency for short distances.

Data Transmission Speeds

Fiber optic cables can transmit data at speeds up to 100 Gbps or higher, with symmetrical upload and download rates, making them ideal for high-demand applications like cloud computing, video conferencing, and large file transfers . Single-mode fiber can maintain 10 Gbps over 40 km without amplification, while multimode fiber can reach 400 Gbps in short-range links . In contrast, coaxial cables typically max out at around 1 Gbps for residential broadband, with advanced DOCSIS 3.1 standards pushing theoretical downstream speeds to 10 Gbps, though practical speeds are often 500–1000 Mbps due to shared bandwidth and signal attenuation .

Latency Considerations

While fiber is often marketed as faster, coaxial cables can transmit RF signals at about 87% the speed of light, compared to fiber's 67% due to the refractive index of glass . This means that for very short distances, coax may have slightly lower latency. However, overall network latency is influenced by many factors, including routing, network congestion, and equipment, so fiber's low attenuation and dedicated lines generally provide more consistent performance over longer distances .
