- **Aluminum:** Occasionally used in some armored or hybrid cables for lightweight protective sheathing or as part of grounding systems, especially in aerial or submarine applications .
- **Copper:** Sometimes included in fiber optic cables that require power over fiber or integrated electrical grounding. Copper can also be used in messenger wires for aerial installations to support the cable weight .
- **Other metallic alloys:** Specialized cables may incorporate metallic coatings or layers for chemical resistance, corrosion protection, or enhanced conductivity in hybrid fiber-metal designs .
