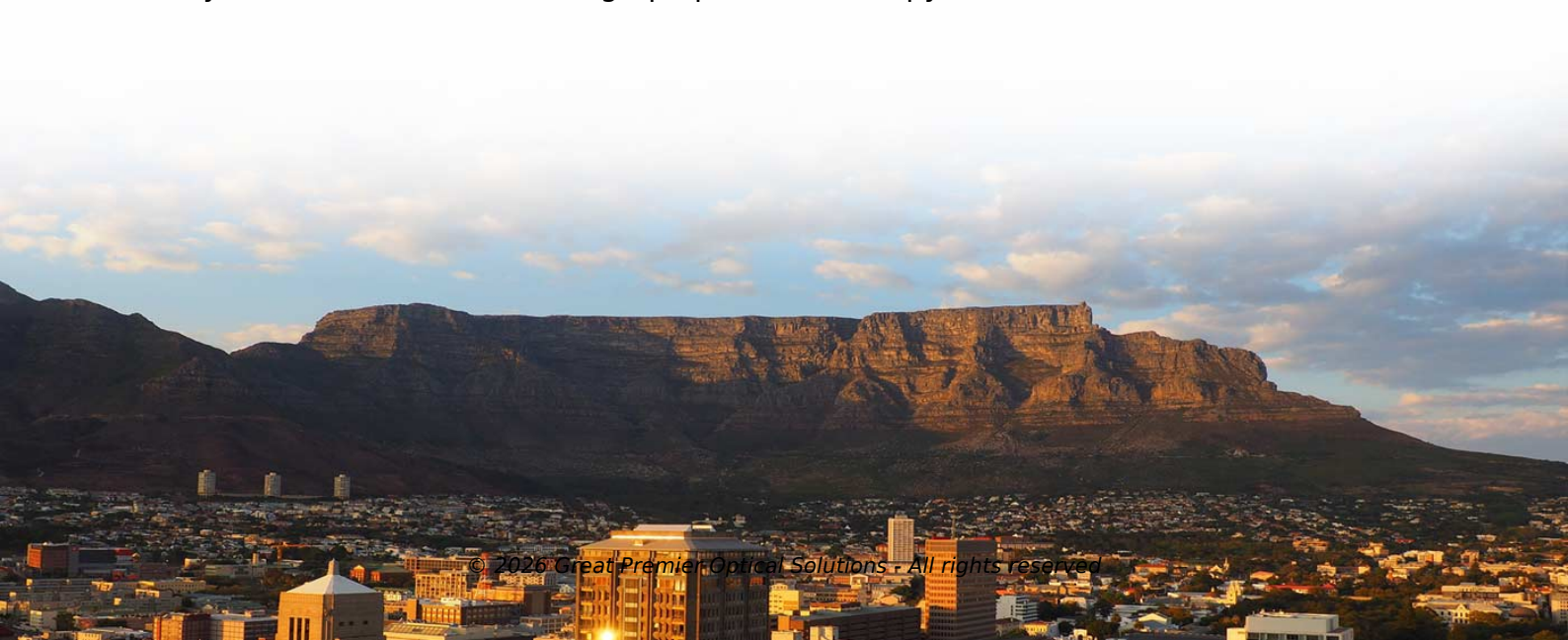


Compensation for land occupied by telecommunications fiber optic cables

A Wayleave agreement or compensation is an annually renewed right of use for utilities over or under a private land giving way to a payment to the landowner. For example, electricity box supply companies may arrange a wayleave agreement payment in order to put poles on your land or cabling under. Land to be acquired may have attached to it an easement over other land which would pass with the land in ordinary private conveyancing, ie the land to be acquired is a 'dominant tenement'.
