

Core Network Switch Routing and Networking

A core network switch is the high-capacity backbone of a network, responsible for ultra-fast routing and aggregation of data between distribution switches and network segments.

Role of Core Switches in Networking

A core switch operates at the core layer of a hierarchical network, forming the backbone that interconnects distribution switches and ensures high-speed data transfer across the network . Unlike access switches, which connect end-user devices, or distribution switches, which manage traffic between access and core layers, core switches focus on rapid packet forwarding, low latency, and high throughput . They typically operate at Layer 3, enabling IP routing between VLANs, subnets, and security zones .

Key Functions

- **High-Speed Data Aggregation:** Core switches consolidate traffic from multiple distribution switches, ensuring efficient communication across the LAN or data center .
- **Routing:** They perform Layer 3 routing, determining optimal paths for data packets between networks using routing protocols, while delegating complex security and QoS tasks to lower layers to maintain speed .
- **Redundancy and Reliability:** Core switches often include dual power supplies, hot-...
