

Distance between emergency lighting and distribution box



Article Overview

The distance between an emergency lighting unit and its distribution box is generally determined by wiring regulations, voltage drop limits, and manufacturer specifications rather than a fixed spacing rule.

Key Considerations

1. **Wiring and Voltage Drop:** Emergency lighting units are typically powered from a central distribution box or circuit. The maximum distance is influenced by the voltage drop along the cable. For low-voltage emergency lighting circuits, the voltage drop should not exceed 3-5% to ensure the luminaire operates correctly during a mains failure. Longer cable runs may require larger conductor sizes to maintain proper voltage at the luminaire. 2. **Manufacturer Specifications:** Each emergency lighting unit may have a maximum cable length recommended by the manufacturer. This ensures the battery backup and charging circuitry function correctly. Always consult the luminaire's datasheet or installation guide for exact limits. 3. **Compliance with Standards:**

- BS 5266-1 (UK) and EN 60598-2-22 provide guidance on emergency lighting installation, including wiring practices, but do not specify a fixed distance from the distribution box .
- NFPA 101 Life Safety Code (US) emphasizes proper illumination and reliable operation along escape routes, indirectly affecting wiring layout and distribution box placement .
