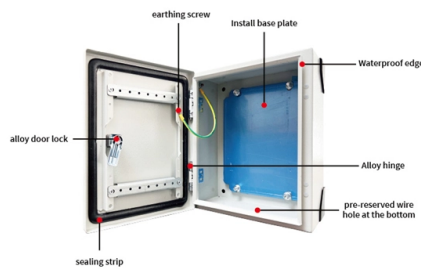


Distance of distribution box from ground

Distribution box and switch box should not exceed 30 meters. Generally, distribution boxes can be divided into three levels of secondary protection, that is, three levels of distribution boxes: general.
