

Do fiber optic cold connectors need grinding How do you grind them

Yes, a fiber optic cold connector typically requires grinding and polishing to ensure proper optical performance.

Why Grinding is Necessary

Fiber optic cold connectors are pre-assembled connectors that have not undergone factory polishing. To achieve low insertion loss, high return loss, and proper end-face geometry, the fiber tip must be ground and polished to remove excess epoxy, smooth the fiber surface, and shape the ferrule end face correctly . Grinding ensures that the fiber end is flat or slightly convex, allowing physical contact (PC) between mated connectors, which is critical for efficient light transmission .

Grinding and Polishing Process

- Epoxy Removal: Excess epoxy securing the fiber in the ferrule is first removed using a coarse polishing film or abrasive pad .
- Rough Grinding: The fiber tip is ground to shape the ferrule and remove surface irregularities. This step uses coarser abrasives to achieve the desired geometry .
- Fine Polishing: After rough grinding, finer abrasives are used to smooth the fiber surface, reduce scratches, and optimize the end-face curvature for minimal backreflection and insertion loss .
- Inspection: The end-face is checked for radius of curvature, apex offset, and fiber height to ensure it meets optical standards
