

Do high-voltage cables need to be placed in fireproof cable trays

High-voltage cables often require fireproof or fire-resistant cable trays, especially in high-risk or critical installations, to prevent fire propagation and ensure operational safety.

Importance of Fireproof Cable Trays

High-voltage cables carry significant electrical energy, and in the event of a fire, they can act as conduits for flames, potentially spreading fire rapidly through a facility. Fireproof cable trays are designed to maintain structural integrity under high temperatures, minimize heat transmission, and prevent the spread of fire between floors or areas, which is critical in data centers, hospitals, high-rise buildings, and industrial plants where uninterrupted power is essential .

Materials and Standards

Fire-resistant cable trays are typically made from steel, aluminum, or fiber-reinforced plastics, with coatings or treatments to enhance fire performance. Some systems, like the Cablofil fireproof trays, are tested according to DIN 4102-12, which subjects the tray and cables to temperatures up to 1000°C for durations of 30, 60, and 90 minutes to ensure fire safety . These trays are increasingly specified for high-voltage installations in sectors such as power, oil, gas, rail, and utilities .
