Overview

148 states that when more than one equipment grounding conductor enters a box, they must be spliced together and a pigtail must run to the device. That short conductor is the pigtail, and its presence reflects one of the most important principles in residential electrical work: keeping the circuit continuous and reliable regardless of what happens at any single device. Instead of running the incoming and outgoing circuit wires directly onto the receptacle terminals, all corresponding wires—hot (black). Daisy Chain vs Pigtail Outlets: Which Method is Safe?

When wiring electrical receptacles in your home, you will encounter two primary methods: daisy chaining and pigtailling. There was probably 5 of these pigtails in the panel. He also twisted a few of the ground wires together and crimped them under a crimp sleeve, then ran a single wire underneath. According to the National Electrical Code (NEC), multiple wires must never be connected directly to a single device terminal, making the pigtail connection a critical safety solution. So, how does a pigtail work?

It uses a short piece of wire as a jumper to safely and securely connect two or more.
