Polyethylene (PE) Sheathing

PE sheaths are widely used for outdoor fiber optic cables because they offer excellent resistance to moisture, UV radiation, and temperature fluctuations. PE is relatively soft, lightweight, and chemically stable, making it suitable for direct-burial, aerial, and feeder cables exposed to harsh environmental conditions. High-density polyethylene (HDPE) variants provide additional toughness and long-term durability. However, PE is flammable and emits no smoke when burned, so it is less suitable for indoor environments where fire safety is critical.

Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) Sheathing

PVC sheaths are commonly used for indoor fiber optic cables, such as in data centers, office buildings, and riser installations. PVC offers good flame retardancy, chemical resistance, and flexibility. It is cost-effective and available in various colors, making it suitable for controlled environments. However, PVC is heavier than PE, can crack under prolonged UV exposure, and emits toxic smoke when burned, which limits its use in outdoor or high-risk fire scenarios.
