A cold connector is a field-installable fiber optic connector that terminates a fiber cable without requiring heat or a fusion splicer. It aligns the bare fiber with a short fiber stub inside the connector body using mechanical clamping or pre-installed index-matching gel, enabling optical signal transmission . This method is widely used in FTTH deployments, emergency repairs, and small-scale installations because it is fast, cost-effective, and does not require specialized equipment .
