

Fiber optic cable securely tied to pillar without slipping

Use a fiber optic tension or anchor clamp with proper brackets to securely attach the cable to a pillar while maintaining tension and preventing slippage.

Recommended Methods

1. Fiber Optic Tension Clamps Tension clamps, also called anchor or dead-end clamps, are designed to hold aerial fiber optic cables under controlled tension. They transfer the cable's tensile load to the supporting structure, such as a pillar, without damaging the delicate fibers inside . These clamps are ideal for outdoor installations where wind, vibration, or environmental stress could otherwise cause slippage. 2. Anchor Brackets and Hooks Install a stainless steel or corrosion-resistant bracket on the pillar to serve as a secure mounting point. The clamp's hook or bail attaches to this bracket, ensuring the cable remains aligned and tensioned . Brackets also help maintain proper spacing and prevent sagging along the cable run. 3. Proper Cable Insertion and Tensioning

- Inspect the cable and clamp for damage before installation.
- Place the cable carefully into the clamp's gripping channel, avoiding twisting or sharp bends that could exceed the minimum bend radius .
- Pull the cable gently to create the required tension; modern wedge-style clamps automatically grip the cable firmly without over-compressing it .
