Article Overview

Fiber optic cold splicing, also known as mechanical splicing, uses connectors or sleeves to join fibers without fusion, offering quick, field-friendly connections with typical attenuation of 0.1–0.3 dB per point.

Overview of Cold Splicing

Cold splicing, or mechanical splicing, is a method of connecting two optical fibers without melting them. It relies on mechanical alignment and index-matching gels to ensure light passes efficiently from one fiber to another. This method is widely used for emergency repairs, field installations, and small-scale FTTH deployments due to its speed and minimal equipment requirements .

Types of Cold Splice Connections

- Mechanical Splice Sleeves
 - Fibers are cleaved and inserted into a sleeve that aligns the cores.
 - The sleeve may use clamps or adhesives to hold fibers in place.
 - Typical insertion loss is around 0.1–0.3 dB, with light loss up to 10% in some cases .
- Fiber Fast Connectors (Cold Connectors)
 - Field-installable connectors that terminate fibers without a fusion splicer.
 - Use pre-installed index-matching gel or mechanical clamping to align the fiber with a short fiber stub inside the connector body.
 - Common types include SC/APC (angled polish, return loss ≥ 60 dB) and SC/UPC (ultra-physical contact, return loss ≥ 50 dB) .
 - Ideal for FTTH drop cables, distribution boxes, and quick restoration scenarios....
