Understanding the Pigtail Structure

A fiber optic pigtail is a short optical fiber with a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare, exposed fiber on the other . The connector end is designed for direct connection to devices, while the bare end is intended for fusion or mechanical splicing to the main fiber cable .

Typical Connection Points

- **Active Equipment:** The connector end can be plugged directly into switches, routers, or optical transceivers that accept the specific connector type (e.g., SC, LC, ST, FC), .
- **Optical Distribution Frame (ODF) or Patch Panel:** In structured cabling setups, the connector end is inserted into an ODF port or patch panel to organize and manage fiber connections .
- **Fiber Splice Tray:** The bare fiber end is fused or mechanically spliced to the incoming fiber cable inside a splice tray, ensuring a low-loss, permanent connection .

Best Practices

- **Match Connector Type:** Ensure the pigtail connector type (SC, LC, ST, FC) matches the port on the equipment or ODF
