

Fire-fighting and non-fire-fighting cables share the same cable tray



Overview

Multicore cables must not mix fire alarm conductors with non-fire circuits. CCTV coax and Cat6 runs should be routed separately from mains unless. Fire alarm cable is the backbone of every fire detection and notification system — connecting smoke detectors, pull stations, horns, strobes, and control panels into a life-safety network governed by NEC Article 760 and NFPA 72. Choosing the right cable type, rating, and shielding configuration is. Correct cabling practices are fundamental to the reliability of life safety, security, and electrical systems. Poor segregation, inadequate fire resistance, or unsuitable fixings can compromise both system performance and occupant safety. The principal reference standards are: BS 5839-1:2025 - Fire. This guidance covers the routing of secondary supply cables from a life safety generator to the ATS (Automatic Transfer Switch), and the final equipment with reference to: The goal: clarify requirements for the diverse cable routing and maintain circuit integrity under fire conditions for systems. All conductors or cables shall be installed using any of the metal wiring methods permitted by 708,10 (C) (1) and, in addition, shall comply with the following, as applicable: All cables for fire alarm, security, signaling systems, and emergency communications shall be shielded twisted pair cables. Standard BS 8519 is a designated code of practice for the selection and installation of fire-resistant power and control cable systems for life safety, fire-fighting and other critical applications. Therefore, understanding the application objectives of these two cable types will help optimize costs and operational.
