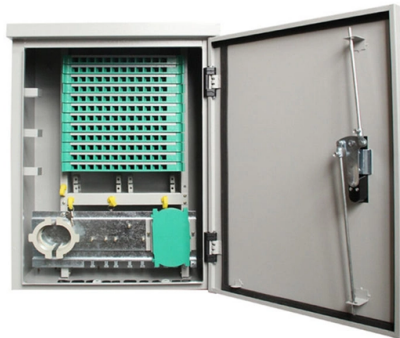


Fire-fighting electrical distribution box markings



Article Overview

Electrical distribution boxes associated with firefighting systems are marked with standardized colors, symbols, and signage to ensure rapid identification and safe operation during emergencies.

Color Codes and Signage

Firefighting electrical distribution boxes are typically marked using red and white color schemes to indicate fire protection equipment and associated circuits. According to DFES guidelines, the cabinet or enclosure should have a white background with a red border, and the signage should be fade- and weather-resistant, mounted above or on the door for clear visibility. This ensures that firefighters can quickly locate and operate the equipment even in low-visibility conditions. Color coding standards often follow NFPA and ASME/ANSI conventions:

- Red with white lettering: Fire protection fluids, circuits, or equipment .
- White background with red border: Fire indicator panels or booster assemblies .
- Blue, green, yellow, or orange: Reserved for other utilities (e.g., compressed air, potable water, flammable liquids) and are generally not used for firefighting electrical boxes .
