

Four-core fiber optic cable wiring sequence



Article Overview

The standard color sequence for a four-core fiber optic cable is Blue, Orange, Green, and Brown according to TIA-598-C.

Standard Wiring Sequence

For a 4-core fiber optic cable, each fiber is individually color-coded to ensure proper identification during splicing or termination. The TIA-598-C standard specifies the following sequence for the first four fibers:

- Blue – Fiber 1
 - Orange – Fiber 2
 - Green – Fiber 3
 - Brown – Fiber 4
- This sequence is consistent for both single-mode (OS1/OS2) and multimode (OM1/OM2/OM3/OM4) cables, although the outer jacket color may differ (yellow for indoor single-mode, black for outdoor, orange or aqua for multimode) .

Typical Configurations

A 4-core cable is often used in one of the following setups:

- Two duplex links: Each duplex link uses two fibers (one for transmit, one for receive).
- One duplex link + two backup fibers: Common in redundancy setups to ensure network reliability
