

Grounding requirements for optical cable distribution boxes



Article Overview

Grounding of an optical cable distribution box is required when metallic components are present, using proper bonding to a central grounding point to ensure safety and system reliability.

Key Principles

Optical fiber itself is dielectric and does not carry electrical current, so fully non-metallic fiber cables do not require grounding. However, when the cable or distribution box contains metallic components such as steel armor, copper strength members, or metallic trays, grounding is essential to prevent electric shock, equipment damage, and fire hazards .

Grounding Requirements for Distribution Boxes

- **Connection to Factory Ground:** Each distribution box must be connected to the facility's central grounding system by a qualified electrician .
- **Ground Wire Sizing:** In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is typically used; in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is recommended .
- **Grounding Path:** Attach a ground wire from a threaded stud at the bottom of the housing to the mounting plate, then from the mounting plate to the central grounding point .
- **Resistance Requirements:** The total ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm to ensure effective dissipation of stray currents .
- **Metallic Cable Components:** Any metallic armor or strength members in the fiber...
