Core Components

Switching Engine: The switching engine is the heart of a core switch, responsible for processing and forwarding data packets at high speed. It reads destination addresses from packet headers and determines the correct output port, directly affecting throughput and latency. Modern core switches often use Application Specific Integrated Circuits (ASICs) to accelerate Layer 3 routing and Layer 2 switching, enabling wire-speed performance across multiple subnets and VLANs.

Interface Modules: Core switches include multiple types of network interfaces, such as Ethernet, fiber optic, and high-speed uplinks. These modules connect the switch to distribution switches, servers, and other network devices. The number and type of interfaces determine the switch's connectivity capacity and supported network topologies.

Switching Matrix: The switching matrix, or switch fabric, connects input ports to output ports internally. It ensures that data flows efficiently between ports without bottlenecks. High-end core switches may implement crossbar or Clos architectures to handle massive data volumes and maintain low latency.

Redundancy and High Availability: Core switches are designed for continuous operation. They often feature dual hot-swappable power supplies, modular cooling fans, and logical redundancy protocols like VRRP or HSRP, allowing a secondary swi...
