

Home electrical distribution box grounding and neutral connection



Overview

According to NEC Article 250, both the neutral and ground wires must be connected only in the main panel or at the first service disconnect. They should never be connected together downstream of the service equipment, such as in subpanels or other parts of the circuits. Confusion often arises when connecting the neutral and ground conductors within a breaker box, as their proper handling depends entirely on the panel's location within the electrical system. These two conductors serve fundamentally different safety functions, even though they may sometimes connect. Your breaker box wiring includes three main wire types: black hot wires carry electricity to outlets, white neutral wires return unused power, and green ground wires prevent electrocution. It carries the unbalanced load in a 120/240-volt.
