

How far apart should a vertical cable tray be installed with a support bracket



Overview

Support spacing for cable trays must align with the manufacturer's instructions, as outlined in NEC 392. Generally, standard trays require supports every 6 to 10 feet, while heavy-duty, long-span trays can handle distances of up to 20 feet between supports. The NEC has a requirement for ladder-type cable trays. To determine the proper spacing. The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material. Proper installation can significantly reduce electromagnetic interference, prevent fire hazards, and improve overall efficiency., with a minimum clear distance of not less than 300 mm. When multiple trays are installed in layers, the spacing between power and weak-current trays should be greater than 150 mm; isolation plates are required at.
