

How far should the third-level distribution box be from the wall



Overview

The National Electrical Code provision 110. 26 clarifies that electrical boxes must be supplied with at least 3 feet of free space surrounding them for safety measures. Choose the right box based on environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1. Likewise, there is also a mounting height rule that must be followed in setting up panels. Select a well-ventilated and dry place to avoid poor heat dissipation causing equipment. The dimension for height of working space for equipment operating at 600 volts (V), nominal, or less to ground and likely to require examination, adjustment, servicing or maintenance while energized shall comply with the 110.
