

How many routers can a fiber optic cable connect to for internet access

A fiber optic cable can support multiple routers, but the practical limit depends on the ONT, router configuration, and network management rather than the fiber cable itself.

Fiber Optic Basics

Fiber optic internet transmits data via light signals through glass or plastic strands, offering extremely high speeds, low latency, and large bandwidth capacity. The fiber line terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts optical signals into electrical signals for your routers. The ONT typically provides one or more Ethernet ports, but most ISPs assign a single public IP address to the connection, which affects how many routers can be directly connected.

Connecting Multiple Routers

You can connect two or more routers to a single fiber connection using the following methods:

- Primary Router with Secondary Router in Access Point or Bridge Mode: Connect the ONT to the WAN port of the primary router. Then connect a LAN port from the primary router to the WAN port of the secondary router. The secondary router can operate in Access Point (AP) or Bridge Mode to extend Wi-Fi coverage or create a separate network.
- Double NAT Setup: If the secondary router is left in router mode, it creates a "dou...
