

# How many stages does a PON beam splitter have



## Article Overview

A PON beam splitter can have either a single stage (centralized) or multiple stages (cascaded), depending on the network design and split ratio.

### Single-Stage (Centralized) Splitters

In a centralized architecture, a single high-ratio splitter (e.g., 1:32 or 1:64) is placed near the OLT (Optical Line Terminal) in a central office or distribution hub. This setup uses one stage, where the feeder fiber connects directly to the splitter, and distribution fibers run from the splitter to each ONT (Optical Network Terminal) at the subscriber premises. This approach minimizes insertion loss and simplifies maintenance, as all outputs are managed from a single location .

### Multi-Stage (Cascaded) Splitters

In a cascaded or distributed architecture, the splitting is done in two or more stages. For example, a 1:64 split can be achieved by first splitting 1:8 at a central location and then splitting each of those outputs 1:8 at a secondary location closer to subscribers. This reduces the number of fibers running from the central office but introduces additional insertion loss due to multiple splitting stages. Cascaded splitters are often used in areas where fiber deployment costs need to be minimized or where subscriber density varies .
