The conduit size for fiber optic cables depends on the cable type, strand count, and installation environment, with typical minimum sizes ranging from 1 inch for small indoor/outdoor cables to 2 inches for larger outdoor or gel-filled cables.

Key Considerations for Conduit Size

Cable Type and Jacket Rigidity: Indoor/outdoor 6-strand cables often require at least a 1-inch conduit, while gel-filled or more rigid outdoor cables may need 1.5 to 2-inch conduits to allow safe pulling and prevent damage at breakout points . **Fill Ratio and Future Growth:** Industry standards recommend an initial fill ratio of 25% and a maximum of 40% for innerducts, ensuring space for future cable additions. For multiple cables in one conduit, the sum of the cable diameters should not exceed the recommended fill ratio . **Bend Radius and Pulling Considerations:** Conduits must accommodate the minimum bend radius of the fiber and allow for smooth pulling. Long-radius sweeps and pull boxes at direction changes help prevent excessive tension and cable damage . **Installation Environment:** Outdoor, underground, or aerial installations almost always require conduit for protection against moisture, rodents, and mechanical damage. Indoor installations may use conduit optionally, especially in commercial or industrial settings . **Conduit Material:** Common materials include Schedule 40 PVC (2-6 inches), Schedule 80 PVC for heavy loads, HDPE (1-4 inches) for direct burial or directional drilling, and innerducts (1-1.25 inches) for subdividin...
