

How many wires are in an 8-core optical cable

Detailed Explanation

An 8-core optical cable consists of eight separate optical fibers housed within a single protective jacket, with each fiber individually coated and often color-coded for identification. These fibers are the “wires” in the context of optical communication, as they carry light signals rather than electrical current.

Cable Structure

- **Central Loose Tube:** Many outdoor 8-core cables, such as the GYXTW type, use a central loose tube that contains all 8 fibers.
- **Strength Members:** To provide mechanical support, cables often include two parallel steel wires or other reinforcing materials to prevent stretching and damage during installation.
- **Protective Layers:** The fibers are surrounded by water-blocking compounds, armoring (like steel tape), and outer jackets to protect against environmental factors such as moisture, rodents, and mechanical stress.
