

How should the fiber optic cable be connected

The most reliable method for connecting fiber optic cables is fusion splicing, complemented by proper handling, connector alignment, and testing to ensure minimal signal loss.

Key Connection Methods

- **Fusion Splicing (Permanent Connection)** Fusion splicing involves melting and fusing the ends of two fibers using an electric arc. This method provides the lowest signal attenuation (0.01–0.03 dB per point) and is ideal for long-distance or permanent installations. It requires a fusion splicer and trained personnel, and the splice points must be protected in specialized enclosures to maintain durability and performance .
- **Active Connection (Connector-Based)** Active connections use fiber optic connectors (plugs and sockets) to join cables. This method is flexible and convenient, allowing easy reconfiguration, but typically results in higher light loss (10–20%) compared to fusion splicing. Proper alignment and locking of connectors are essential to maintain a stable connection .
- **Cold Splicing (Emergency/Mechanical Connection)** Cold splicing uses mechanical sleeves or adhesives to join fibers temporarily. It is quick and reliable for short-term use, with typical attenuation of 0.1–0.3 dB per point. However, connections may become unstable over time, so this method is not recommended for permanent installations .
- **Non-Splicing Physical Connection** Advanced physical connection methods, such as V-groove alignment with matching liquids, can achieve near 100% fusion success without splicing. These are suitable for FTTR (Fiber to the Room) solutions and speci...
