

How to calculate the support frame for vertical cable trays



Overview

Cable tray support quantity can be calculated using a simple formula: $\text{Support Quantity} = \text{Total Length} \div \text{Support Spacing} + 1$ $20 \div 2 + 1 = 11$ supports In a typical project, a 20-meter cable tray with 2-meter spacing requires 11 supports. For licensed electricians, mastering these principles is essential. Calculate cable tray fill ratio, weight loading, and derating factors for multi-standard compliance. IEC 61537 covers cable tray and cable ladder systems for the support and accommodation of cables, while NEC Article 392 governs cable.
