

# How to connect a single-core optical fiber to an optical switch

To connect a single-core (single-mode) optical fiber to an optical switch, you need a compatible SFP/SFP+ transceiver, the correct fiber type, and proper connectors, ensuring transmit and receive ends are correctly aligned.

### Required Components

- **Patch Panel or Media Converter (Optional):** For organized cabling or if the switch lacks SFP ports, a media converter can convert fiber to copper Ethernet ( ).

### Connection Steps

- **Insert the SFP Module:** Plug the single-mode SFP transceiver into the switch's SFP port.
- **Connect the Fiber:** Attach the fiber cable to the SFP module. For single-core fiber, ensure transmit (TX) on one end connects to receive (RX) on the other and vice versa ( ).
- **Verify Compatibility:** Confirm that both switches or devices use single-mode fiber,...
