

How to neatly bundle cables in cable trays

Choose the Right Cable Tray

Select a tray type suitable for your application, such as ladder trays, wire mesh trays, or solid-bottom trays. Ladder trays are ideal for long runs and heavy cables, providing mechanical support and smooth bends, while wire mesh trays offer flexibility and ventilation for lighter cables. Ensure the tray width accommodates the total cable volume without overcrowding.

Organize and Group Cables

- Separate by type or function: Keep power, data, and control cables in distinct bundles to reduce interference and simplify maintenance.
- Maintain proper spacing: Use a rung spacing of 6–9 inches (150–230 mm) for ladder trays to support cables and prevent sagging.
- Plan cable paths: Route cables along the tray's centerline and avoid sharp bends to respect the minimum bend radius of each cable.

- Cable ties: Use Velcro or nylon ties to bundle cables at regular intervals, typically...
