

How to route cable trays to the shortest path

- Perforated or solid-bottom trays: Useful for sensitive or low-voltage cables, protecting against dust and water .
- Wire mesh (basket) trays: Lightweight and flexible, suitable for data or low-voltage cables . Ensure the tray material matches environmental conditions (e.g., galvanized steel for outdoor use, aluminum or fiberglass for corrosive areas),
