

How to run fire-resistant copper-clad cables through cable trays



Overview

Surfaces should be coated with fire-retardant paint to slow flame spread and increase heat resistance. Install fire barriers within the tray to isolate different fire zones. When cable trays pass through walls or floors, seal openings using fire-rated penetration. This guide provides suggestions for various methods, equipment and tools that have been found practical based on field experience during the installation of Prysmian Group's fire resistive Lifeline® MC and Lifeline® MC LSZH Cable systems in fire-rated applications. The intent of this guide, along with Segregation of Power and Signal Cables: Power (high-voltage) and signal (low-voltage) cables should be routed separately, using dedicated trays to minimize electromagnetic interference. Tray Type and Material Selection Indoor: Painted steel or galvanized trays. For suggested grips, supports and fasteners. Mineral-insulated copper-clad cable is a variety of electrical cable made from copper conductors inside a copper sheath, insulated by inorganic magnesium oxide powder. The name is often abbreviated to MICC or MI cable, and colloquially known as pyro.
