

How to use a transceiver optical module

To use a transceiver with an optical module, select the correct module, insert it into the device slot, connect the appropriate optical fiber, and follow safety and compatibility guidelines.

Selecting the Correct Optical Module

Before installation, ensure the optical module matches your network requirements:

- Transmission distance: Modules vary from short-range (300m) to long-range (80km). Choose based on your network layout .
- Wavelength and type: Check the module label for wavelength (e.g., 850 nm) and ensure it matches the peer device .
- Fiber type and connector: Use the same fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) and connector type (LC/PC, SC/PC, MPO/PC) at both ends .

Installing the Optical Transceiver

- Prepare the slot: Remove any dust caps from the SFP/SFP+ port.
- Insert the module: Gently push the transceiver into the slot until it clicks and locks. If resistance occurs, flip the module and try again .
- Connect the fiber: Remove the dust cap from the fiber connector and insert it into the transceiver. Avoid bending or tightly bundling fibers to prevent signal loss .
- Secure the connection: Ensure the fiber is fully seated and the module is locked in place.
