

How to use the two optical ports on a switch

Two optical ports on a switch typically consist of a transmit (TX) and receive (RX) pair, often implemented as SFP or combo ports, enabling fiber-optic connectivity for high-speed network links.

Types of Optical Ports

SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) ports are hot-pluggable interfaces used for fiber or copper connections, supporting speeds from 1G to 10G and beyond. They allow flexible deployment with single-mode fiber for long distances or multi-mode fiber for shorter distances, depending on network requirements. Combo ports combine an SFP port and an RJ45 copper port into a single logical interface. Only one of the two can be active at a time: if the optical port is used, the copper port is disabled, and vice versa. This provides flexibility during network transitions from copper to fiber without requiring additional switch ports.

Function and Usage

Optical ports are primarily used to connect switches over longer distances than copper allows, often in backbone or uplink scenarios. Each optical port pair includes a TX sender and RX receiver, ensuring proper bidirectional communication. When connecting two switches, the optical modules must match in type (single-mode or multi-mode), wavelength, and optical power range to ensure reliable communication. SFP modules are inserted into the switch's SFP port and communicate directly with t...
