

How to wire a KNX distribution box

Wiring a KNX distribution box involves connecting the KNX power supply, bus lines, and devices according to a planned topology while ensuring proper labeling, power management, and safe installation.

Step 1: Plan Your KNX System

Before wiring, plan the system layout by dividing the building into zones (rooms, floors, or functional areas) and listing all devices such as switches, sensors, actuators, and interfaces. Determine the topology—line, tree, or star—avoiding loops, as KNX does not support closed loops. Consider future expansion by leaving spare capacity in the distribution box and calculating the maximum number of devices per line (typically 64 devices per line, extendable with line repeaters) ().

Step 2: Install the KNX Power Supply

Mount the KNX power supply inside the distribution box. Ensure it is rated for the total current of all devices on the line. Each KNX line can have a maximum cable length of 1000 meters, and devices should be no more than 350 meters from the power supply ().

Step 3: Connect the KNX Bus Lines

Use twisted pair KNX bus cables to connect devices. The bus can be wired in a daisy chain or star configuration, with spurs allowed but loops prohibited. Label each cable clearly for easier maintenance and troubleshooting. If expanding beyond a single lin...
