

Installation of Pigtail Splitter

A pigtail fiber optic splitter is installed by fusion splicing its fiber tails to the main fiber cable and connecting the pre-terminated connectors to network equipment or distribution panels.

Understanding the Pigtail Splitter

A pigtail splitter is a compact optical splitter with a Planar Lightwave Circuit (PLC) chip inside a small tube, from which unjacketed or lightly buffered fibers extend. One end of each fiber is pre-terminated with connectors such as LC, SC, or FC, while the other end is designed for splicing to the main fiber network. This design allows for space-efficient integration into splice closures, optical distribution frames (ODF), or patch panels.

Tools and Materials Needed

- Fusion splicer
- Fiber cleaver
- Fiber stripper and cleaning tools
- Heat shrink sleeves or splice protectors
- Pigtail splitter (pre-terminated)
- Patch cords and adapters (SC/APC, LC/UPC, etc.)
- Splice tray or distribution box
