Having too few circuit breakers in a distribution box can compromise safety, increase the risk of overloads, and limit future expansion.

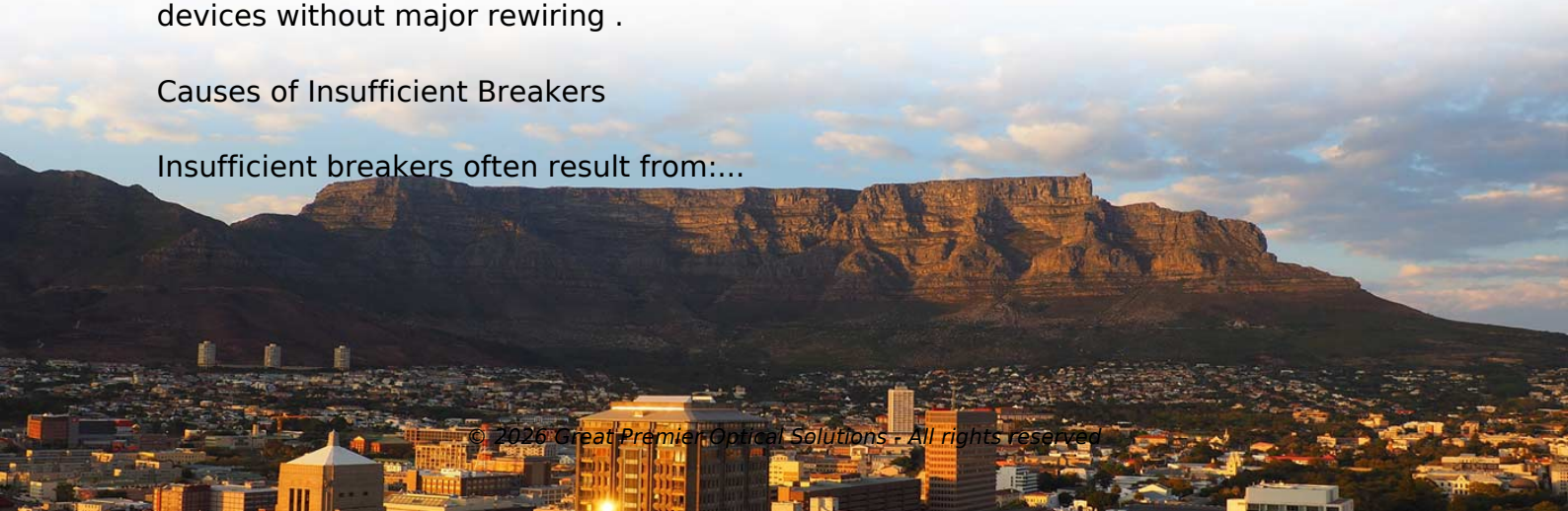
Risks of Insufficient Circuit Breakers

A distribution box is designed to protect electrical circuits and connected devices from overloads and short circuits while ensuring personal safety through residual current devices (RCDs) or ground fault protection . If there are not enough breakers, several risks arise:

- Overloading circuits, which can cause overheating of wires and potential fire hazards .
- Reduced protection for individual circuits, meaning a fault in one area could affect multiple devices or areas.
- Difficulty in maintenance and troubleshooting, as fewer breakers make isolating specific circuits harder .
- Limited capacity for future upgrades, preventing the addition of new circuits or devices without major rewiring .
