The designation 8a1a refers to a type of single-mode optical fiber, typically used for long-distance and high-bandwidth applications. Single-mode fibers have a small core diameter of about 8–10 microns, which allows only one mode of light to propagate through the fiber. This design minimizes signal loss and modal dispersion, enabling data transmission over long distances with high integrity and low attenuation .

Single-Mode vs. Multimode

- Single-mode fiber (SMF): Features a narrow core ($\sim 9\text{ }\mu\text{m}$) that supports a single light path. Ideal for long-haul communication, backbone networks, and high-speed data transmission. It offers superior performance over long distances due to minimal signal distortion .
- Multimode fiber (MMF): Has a larger core ($50\text{--}62.5\text{ }\mu\text{m}$) that allows multiple light modes to propagate simultaneously. Best suited for short-distance applications, such as within data centers or local area networks, where cost efficiency and ease of installation are prioritized .
