

Is a distribution box considered an office supply

A distribution box is generally considered an office supply if it is a low-cost, consumable item used in daily business operations, but not if it is a durable, long-term asset.

Classification Criteria

Office supplies are tangible items that are used regularly and replenished frequently to support business operations, such as pens, paper, printer toner, and small packaging materials . They are typically current assets and are expensed in the year they are used . In contrast, office equipment or capital assets are durable, high-cost items with a useful life exceeding one year, such as printers, copiers, servers, or specialized machinery .

Distribution Box Considerations

- Disposable or short-term use: If the distribution box is a cardboard or plastic box used for shipping, storing, or organizing office materials and is replaced frequently, it is classified as an office supply or operational supply .
- Durable or reusable: If the distribution box is a heavy-duty, long-lasting container intended for repeated use over multiple years, it may be considered equipment or a capital asset and should be depreciated rather than expensed as a supply .
