Connection Type: A fiber optic router works with fiber internet through an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the fiber optic signals into Ethernet for the router to distribute to your devices. Regular routers typically connect directly to a modem for DSL or cable internet and are not optimized for fiber signals . **Speed and Performance:** Fiber routers are built to handle the high bandwidth and low latency of fiber networks, making them ideal for streaming, gaming, and multiple device usage. Regular routers can work with fiber internet but may require adapters and often cannot fully utilize the maximum speeds offered by fiber . **Device Setup:** In a fiber setup, the ONT acts like a modem, and the fiber router connects to it to provide Wi-Fi or wired connections. In contrast, a cable modem router combines the modem and router in one device and works with coaxial cables . **Reliability and Stability:** Fiber routers offer more stable connections and are less susceptible to interference compared to traditional copper-based routers, which can be affected by electromagnetic noise .
